Each year, Manitobans generously donate more than 17,000 hours to create an enjoyable experience for patrons and performers.

Volunteer roles at the Fringe Festival include selling tickets and ushering for shows, keeping the drinks flowing at our beverage pavilions, facilitating fun with our young Fringers at Kids Fringe, answering patron questions, and keeping our indoor and outdoor spaces clean.

Performing companies are accepted through a lottery process and perform at 30 venues in and around Winnipeg's Exchange District.
