He also produces *Comedy Gold* a popular show in Queens, New York.

Gabe has appeared on *The Moth Radio Hour* on BBC Radio 4 & NPR and wrote for the 2019 and 2020 New York Video Game Awards with the writers of the *Daily Show with Trevor Noah*.
