- **THE SOUNDS:** The Fringe festivities kick off at noon with live music by *The Funky Miracles* on the Bell MTS Outdoor Stage. The stage will stay lively with performances from *Duncan Cox* (2pm), *Kim Reimer Band* (6pm), *Brandi Vezina* (8pm) and *Heartbreak Highway* (10pm).
- **THE SIGHTS:** In classic Fringe fashion, Buskers will take the stage to awe and delight with daring feats. See the talents of *Chris without the Hat* (1pm), *Hoop & Hat* (7pm) and *Flame Syndicate* (9pm).
- SNACK, SIP & SHOP: Our onsite food and merchant vendors open at noon daily until midnight. Choose from a variety of local offerings such as Farm Dog, KYU Grill, India Palace, Nucci's Gelati and many more. Vendors, including Waves and WhatKnot, Caged Designs and Worth a Wink, will showcase local artisanal wares.
